1. Call to Order

Chief Schar called the meeting to order at 1332 hrs.

2. Approval of Minutes

A. September 22, 2021 Minutes

B. November 17, 2021 – Meeting Notes

Sgt. Taylor made the motion to approve the September 22, 2021 minutes and November 17, 2021 meeting notes. DC Stefanson seconded and the motion was approved by unanimous voice vote.

3. Staff Reports:

DD Lamela noted six (6) TCs in training, two (2) in police dispatch, two (2) in call taking, and two (2) in classroom. Work continues with Dave Jordan for access to WebRMS, and the ETSB on LiveMUM settings and configurations. The group advised the training documentation, to run CQHs in vehicles, added to PowerDMS. The TCs are able to send SOS images, other documents, and pictures to vehicles. Group advised to review the December stats emailed yesterday, as the ones in the packet needed to be corrected.

DD Baarman noted work with Fulton on the outdoor weather sirens, fixed an antenna and tested the system, which seems to be working now. Techs work to install microwaves to eliminate the remaining Comcast lines, and decommission tower sites.

4. Old Business:

A. Blue Shirt Committee - Update

CM Payne advised the Blue Shirt Committee transitioned to Midnight shift CM Barber. A meeting invite should be issued in February.

Chief Schar noted DD Lamela discussed earlier, and asked if there were further questions, and there were none.

5. New Business

A. Written Directive –

1. 11.00.00 – Police Dispatch

Chief Schar asked if any discussion was needed, and none was requested.

Sgt. Taylor made a motion to approve 11.00.00 Police Dispatch and DC Stefanson seconded. The motion was approved by unanimous voice vote.

2. 09.14.00 – Domestic Violence Surveillance Response.

DD Lamela noted two updates: the new CAD code of Alarm-PD GPS, and Bischoff calls would be included in this CAD Event type. The group had no questions.

Sgt. Taylor made a motion to approve 9.14.00 Domestic Violence Surveillance Response and DC Stefanson seconded. The motion was approved by unanimous voice vote.

B. Mental Health Legislation

Illinois has not yet provided any information on what we need to do. Discussed with EMS Region 8 and awaiting information.

6. Other Business

CM Payne worked with a local DuPage County group called Zero suicide. They will determine QR codes for residents to obtain information on county mental health resources and requested police departments include them on their websites and on Public Education flyers. Sgt. Todd Carlson asked if CM Payne knew of any police department social workers on the group, which she did not. He noted it sounded like both groups might be working on the same thing and should communicate. CM Payne noted she would contact Sgt. Carlson offline to discuss further. Chief Schar asked if CM Payne would update agencies when all of the information was ready and she confirmed.

7. At 1347 hrs. DC Stefanson made the motion to adjourn and Sgt. Taylor seconded. The motion was approved unanimous voice vote.
